Gun Purchases & Trade-in Policy

- a. The sale price of all guns is determined by the owner of that gun at the time of sale.
- b. No seller is forced to sell at a price lower than they are willing to accept. If the seller is not happy with the price they should not sell, Buyers should not purchase if they think the price too high.
- c. Buyers are never obligated to purchase any gun. They do so at their own choice and at the price that the gun seller agrees to sell. This applies to Sharpshooters as much as it does to our customers.
- d. Sharpshooters reserve the right to accept or reject any offers made and to determine on a case-by-case basis to take a particular gun on trade or not to allow trade towards any particular gun(s).
- All trades/Sales of Guns are final when the payment is complete. If a return is authorized by the Store management, <u>a 15% restocking fee will be</u> <u>charged!</u>
- f. All Used Firearms are sold with the belief, on our part, that they are in proper working order. However, they are sold in "As Is" condition. If you discover a problem, please return the gun within 15 days, without attempting any repairs and we will work with you to correct the situation. Used Guns that have been repaired by the customer or past 15 days from the sale are not returnable. *Repairs will then be at normal Gunsmith Rates.*
- g. We reserve the right <u>to not allow</u> any particular gun to be purchased on Lay-A-Way plan.
- h. Lay-A-Way on a consignment gun <u>must be approved by the seller</u>.
